ANNOUNCING CONESTOGA GOLF CLUB RESIDENT-ONLY SPRING MIXED LEAGUE - 2025

The inaugural Conestoga Golf Club Resident-Only Spring Mixed League ("League"), which is currently forming and will begin play soon, offers another great playing opportunity for our Sun City golfing community. Spaces are limited, so sign up now!! Sign-up sheets are available at the Pro Shop or by emailing Bob Muszar at bobmuszar@yahoo.com.

General Description: Each Sunday afternoon, for six consecutive weeks beginning April 27 and ending June 1, teams of up to six golfers (4 primary and 2 designated alternates) will field 4 golfers each to compete in a 9-hole, alternative format match (scramble, shamble, best ball, etc.). Handicapping and tee box assignments will be structured in a manner that is welcoming and fair to players of all levels.

The League offers a friendly competitive format. Teams will accumulate points based on the point distribution announced for each match. Team prizes and/or cash will be awarded at the end of the League based on points earned. Teams and individuals also will have opportunities to earn additional awards on a weekly basis.

Weekly matches will be followed by an opportunity to socialize with fellow golfers. An awards luncheon will be held on the Sunday following the end of League play. The cost of the luncheon will be approximately \$25 (final cost yet to be determined).

The emphasis of this League will be to have fun and socialize.

League Schedule: Matches will be played each Sunday Afternoon with a 4:30 p.m. shotgun start on April 27; May 4,11,18,25; and June 1. The awards luncheon will be Sunday June 8 at 1230.

Field Limited: The playing field will be limited to a maximum of 10 teams. Entry will be on a first come, first served basis.

Team Make-Up: Each team will consist of 4 primary golfers and up to 2 alternates; each of whom will be identified at the time of registration. Each team must include at least one opposite gender member amongst its 4 primary golfers (3 ladies-1man, 1 lady-three men, 2+2, etc.). There will be no substitutions following the close of registration. Each team will designate a Team Captain who will provide the League Coordinator with the team's roster for each week of play by the designated deadline. League communications will be directed to Team Captains for distribution to their team members.

Individual Registration: Residents may sign up as individuals and the League Coordinators will attempt to make up teams of individuals following the guidelines described above. However, the League may not be able to accommodate all individual sign-ups – better to register as a team if possible.

Handicapping/Tee Box Assignments: All Ladies will play from the Jade Tees. Men 65 or under will play from the Copper/Silver Combination Tees. Men over 65 will play from the Copper Tees. The League Committee reserves the right to adjust tee box assignments based on individual circumstances and the principles of fair play.

Registration Fees: Registration fees will be \$600.00 *per team* due at the time of registration. These fees will cover whatever administrative costs we may have and will fund the various prize pools. The prize pool will be divided into funds to pay for the prize to be awarded to the league champions, point money to be awarded to each team and various raffle prizes.

Green Fees: Regular Conestoga Resident and Passholder green fees will apply and are payable at the Pro Shop prior to the beginning of each round.

Optional Hole-In-One Insurance: Optional Hole-In-One insurance will be available for \$30.00 per team. If paid out before the end of the League, teams will have the option to buy-in again. If not paid out during the course of the League, the money will be folded into the final prize pools and paid accordingly.

Method of Payment: Registration, Hole-In-One Insurance and Banquet fees are payable by cash or check only. Checks should be made payable to the Conestoga Golf Club Spring Mixed League (CGCSML).

League Communications: Prior to the beginning of play, a rules sheet and registration form will be developed and made available. During League play, communications will be directed to team captains. It will be the team captains' responsibility to distribute the information to their teams.

End of League Critique: At the close of the 2025 season, a meeting of team captains will be held to critique League performance and to consider suggestions/options for the 2026 season.
