## **MEETING NOTES:**

- I. Introduction of Committee Members and those in attendance (In attendance: Mark Whetzel, PGA Conestoga Director of Golf, Rick Jackson Conestoga Director of Revenue and Operations, Dan Erhart Men's League 18 Hole President, Kathy Cho Women's 9 Hole President. Excused: Ryan Scott Conestoga Director of Outside Services and Tournaments, Todd Koller Men's 9 Hole President, Bob Muszar Advisory Committee Events Coordinator, Cheri Erhart, Mike Paluso, Monica Paluso)
- II. Updates Mark & Rick, (Rick provided an overview of league bookings, as well as general booking trends. Mark highlighted the strong interest in the Nine and Beer Men's league. Additionally, Todd proposed adding a couple's league format that would run every other Thursday, opposite the Men's Nine and Beer league schedule.)
- III. Encourage residents to contact Committee members regarding Golf Club matters. (Mark reiterated the importance of the SCM Resident Advisory Committee and the oversight each committee member provides. Your role is crucial in facilitating communication between Conestoga and the SCM residents. Specifically, your oversight helps us to keep residents informed about the improvements we are making to the SCM golf experience, gather feedback on other golf course ideas, enhance our communications, and most importantly, listen to and address any concerns or suggestions from the SCM residents. Mark thanked the committee for their continued dedication and for helping us ensure a positive golf experience for all SCM residents.)

- Cost \$39 per player, 18 winners, one per hole.
- Bev Cart will have complimentary non-alcoholic drinks.

- Lunch provided before the event, Yardley Burgers in 1880.
- Team limits 6 players per team, 10 teams as a goal and 12 teams max.
- Prizes are \$50 per closest to pin on each hole. (Average hole length will be 130 yards 90 Yards.)
- Sign-up sheet in the golf shop, full payment required when signing up. SCM Residents only.
- Marketing, emailing all our 18- and 9-hole leagues.

- VI. Crossing Areas / Errant Tee Shots: (Mark updated on the flashing crosswalk signs for the golf course road crossings. Conestoga, SCM HOA, and Pulte Homes have agreed to cover the upfront costs, despite these being City roads. These companies will fund the purchase and installation, after which the equipment will be deeded to the City for perpetual maintenance. This collaboration is a positive step for safety. We will continue working with all parties to complete the project. Mark also reminded the committee about the errant tee shots that happen occasionally on the golf course. It is unfortunate, indeed, but the occasional errant golf ball and the damage that sometimes results is a byproduct of living on a golf course. That's why the Sun City Mesquite CC&Rs specifically notify homeowners of this hazard (Section 11.2)
- VII. Closing remarks: (Dan asked about the pace of play during our peak season and maybe blocking out specific times during peak season to help with pace of play. Mark and Rick told the committee this is already something we are doing.
